



## **TOWN OF MASSEY DRIVE**

### **NUISANCE REGULATIONS**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Town of Massey Drive(Nuisance) Regulations, 1993
2. Interpretations: In these regulations:
  - (a) “ Act” means the Municipalities Act
  - (b) “Council” means the Town Council of Massey Drive
  - (c) “Municipality” means the Town of Massey Drive
3. No person shall create a noise within the Municipality, through the use of fire-arms, fireworks or other similar noise-making devices, except as may be approved by Council and subject to approval of law enforcement or other regulator agencies.
4. No person shall create a noise within the Municipality, through the use of shouting or noise-making devices, for the purpose of selling wares, soliciting business or attracting attention, except as may be approved by Council.
5. No person shall create a noise within the Municipality, through the use of motor vehicle horns, except an may be reasonably necessary in the opinion of Council, for the safety and warning of traffic and pedestrians.
6. No person shall use, within the Municipality, a lawnmower, chainsaw, snowmobile or other machinery or equipment which may disturb the peace and quiet of a neighborhood, between the hours 11:00pm of any day to 7:00am of the following day, except as may otherwise be approved by Council.
7. No person shall keep or permit to be kept in any building, premises or yard or any part thereof in the Municipality any dog which by reason of barking or howling is a nuisance to persons in the Municipality.

8. No person shall create a noise within the Municipality, through the use of a motor vehicle that has no muffler or a defective muffler, except as may be in necessary, in the opinion of Council, to move such motor vehicle to a location for associated repair, subject to the approval of law enforcement officials under the Highways Traffic Act.
9. No person shall create a noise within the Municipality, through the squealing of tires of a motor vehicle, which in the opinion of Council, is caused by necessary braking, turning or setting in motion or such motor vehicle.
10. Nothing in these regulations shall be deemed to prohibit:
  - (a) The sounding of and bell, horn, siren of other warning device of any vehicle where the law requires, of when responding to an emergency.
  - (b) The ring of church bells or chimes.
  - (c) The sounding of railway signals.
  - (d) The sounding of motor vehicle horns in a wedding procession or in parades permitted by Council.
11. Pursuant to section 414 subsection 1 (ee) every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions or these regulations, is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) or in default of payment to a period of imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days or to both such fine and period of imprisonment.
12. These Regulations were amended by a resolution of Council at a meeting held on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2011 and will come in effect on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2011.
13. All previous adopted (Nuisance) regulations of the Municipality are hereby repealed.
