Councilor Wiseman asked if cleanup week had been schedule until October 21 how come the dumpsters were gone by October 20 and that when a resident showed up at 7:15 on Tuesday night, there was no one there and on access to the dumpster when it had been told to residents that the dumpsters would have been available until 8PM both Tuesday and Wednesday Night. Rodger H. to council that cleanup week was done by Thursday so he had the dumpsters removed and he would check into why there was no access to the dumpsters before 8pm on Tuesday night. Council asked Rodger to check with the resident and see if he could help the resident out with the stuff they still had that they were trying to dispose of.

Deputy Mayor Piercey informed council that the Fire Department annual dinner and dance would be held on November 12 at the town hall. Tickets are on sale for the public to purchase. Deputy Mayor Piercey told council that this year they have a fire fighter with 20 years service and she has ordered the gift that council normally gives for 20 years. The department also has a member with 35 years service and she was asking council what they would like to do for this fire fighter. Council discussed. Council will set up a standard for years of service for the fire department.

Rodger H. told council that the capital works application for the salt and sand storage shed had been submitted and that the estimate came in at \$3546,500 and that it would be a 60-40 funding so the town's portion would be \$140,000.00 and would have to be budgeted in the 2023 budget. He then informed council that the force main repair on Link Pond Drive cost about \$75,000.00 and that he has sent a special assistance application to Municipal Affairs for help.
